**THE RITUAL GESTURE OF THE EXCHANGE OF PEACE ON JAN. 1:** On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, December 8, Pope Francis published his Message for the 50<sup>th</sup> World Day of Peace, 1 January 2017: *Nonviolence: a Style of Politics for Peace*. According to the liturgical calendar, the celebration on

January 1 of the Solemnity of Mary the Holy Mother of God could be a special moment to invite assemblies of the faithful to reflect on the significance of exchanging the sign of the Lord's peace.
